

“Storehouses of History”
A new exhibit at the Montgomery Museum

Barns are the theme of a new photo exhibit at the Montgomery Museum. *“Storehouses of History”* is the work of photographer, Susan Guess. Guess's photographs feature historic barns in the area. Some are abandoned and some are still in use but all have a story of their own. In her lectures, she will tell the little known facts about barns; how and why they are built the way they were, the materials and tools used and she even shares a recipe for paint used on barns. Barns will never look quite the same again. The exhibit will be in place during January and February.
